ArcticNet 2025 in Calgary

The ArcticNet Annual Scientific Meeting will be held at the Calgary Telus Convention Centre 15–18 December 2025. ArcticNet was founded in Canada in 2003 as an organization to advance knowledge that supports strategies and national policies for addressing the impacts and opportunities of climate change in the Arctic. ArcticNet supports research that is interdisciplinary, cooperative, and innovative, accomplished through strong partnerships characterized by a diversity of knowledge. ArcticNet's network of partnerships includes 60 Indigenous organization, 12 Canadian government agencies, almost 50 communities, more than 40 post-secondary institutions, and collaborating research teams from over 25 countries (<https://arcticnet.ca/about-us/>). The conference coincides with the Arctic Institute of North America's 80th birthday celebrations to be held 16 December at The Grand in downtown Calgary. Conference participants and invited guests will attend this event, which will include the presentation of some of AINA's archival films.
